



# SITE INFORMATION

## BOOKING & ARRIVAL

The caravan and campsite is open all year round. There may be occasions when bookings can't be taken due to events taking place in the park. Please call to check availability. You must be over 18 to make a booking.

All pitches must be booked and paid for at least 24 hours in advance. Please note that all payments are non-refundable.

On arrival go to the Gift Shop between the hours of 12pm and 4pm (winter) or 5pm (summer) for your pitch number and camping key. A £20 (cash) returnable deposit is required. The camping key is the key to the main gate and the fob for the toilet and shower facilities which are situated at the Golf Club. Please note that the facilities in the Golf Club House are not to be used for washing kitchen utensils.

## OPENING TIMES & CAR PARKING

The car park gates are locked overnight.

**The Hall** is open daily from 10.30am - 5pm with last admission at 4.30pm during the summer season. The Farming Museum opening times are listed on our website.

**The Victorian Walled Garden** is open daily from 10.30am. Last admission is 4.30pm (Summer) 3.30pm (Winter).

**The Splashpad** operates daily from 11am to 5pm throughout the Summer.

**The Gift Shop** is open from 10.30am to 5pm daily (4pm Winter)

**The Stableyard Café** is currently open from 10.30am to 5pm daily (4pm Winter)

If you unlock the car park gates at any time, please lock them immediately behind you. This is for your security as well as ours.

You must leave by 11.30am on the day of your departure. Please leave the pitch clean and tidy and return your keys and fob to the Gift Shop.

The maximum length of stay is 14 consecutive nights. One extra car per pitch is permitted.



## NORMANBY PARK & GROUNDS

Your booking allows entry to the park and grounds plus the Farming Museum and Hall when open. Please check the website for opening times.

### PITCHES

Numbered pitch markers are provided on site and are placed to mark the centre of the pitch. You must park/pitch in the designated space only. The pitches are laid out to ensure that there is 6 metres between the walls of adjacent caravans/tents to avoid the spread of fire.

### SHOWER/TOILET FACILITIES & WASTE DISPOSAL

Shower and toilet facilities are available 24 hours a day at Normanby Hall Golf Club. Access to these is shown on the attached map.

The park toilets are open during the park opening hours. A chemical toilet disposal point is provided on site. The contents of chemical toilets must be disposed of only in the disposal point provided (see map) Disposable nappies must not be emptied in to the chemical toilet disposal point. Please dispose of these along with any other rubbish in the bins provided. Waste water from caravans must be collected in a bucket (do not allow to overflow) and emptied at the disposal point.


Refuse should be placed in the bin provided. There are recycling facilities beside the Gift Shop for plastic bottles, cans and glass - please use these.

### DOG SUPERVISION

Dogs are allowed on the caravan and camping site, but must be kept on a lead at all times. You must clean up after your dog. Locations of dog bins are shown on the attached map. As we have livestock on site, please be a responsible dog owner.


### CHILD SUPERVISION

During your stay supervision of children is paramount as the camp site is adjacent to a municipal golf course and practice range. Children wandering onto these areas are at risk. Less common but more serious injuries can happen if someone gets hit by a golf ball. Children must be supervised by a parent or carer at all times.



## BARBECUES

Barbecues are permitted on site. Please ensure that the barbecue is raised sufficiently off the ground to minimise the risk of fire and to avoid damage to the grass areas. A fire extinguisher is available in case of emergencies (see map). **Fires must not be lit on site.**



## SITE SAFETY & NOISE

Emergency instructions are given on site. Please familiarise yourself with these on arrival. We ask that you note that the nearest public telephone is situated outside the main gates to the car park, 450 metres from the caravan and camping site. You should bring a mobile telephone with you in case of emergencies. There is an emergency telephone with limited dial-out situated in the Golf Club.

Loud music is not to be played on site. Also, please be mindful of other park users and keep noise to a minimum early in the morning and late at night.

### Special safety considerations

**⚠ Carbon monoxide can kill** - Never use a fuel-burning appliance inside your tent or awning - even a cooling barbecue can be lethal

**⚠ Fire** - If there is a fire, leave your unit and warn others by shouting "fire". Call the fire brigade on 999, giving the address and postcode on the front of this leaflet. Make sure someone tells a member of the site team.

**⚠ Electricity** - Take care using electricity on site, conditions will be different from those at home.

**⚠ Fuel** - Be especially careful when storing and using flammable fuels such as gas and petrol.

**⚠ Safety on site** - Be aware that large vehicles are moving around the site. Keep out of their way and ensure children are aware of the dangers.

**⚠ Trip hazards** - Look out for guy ropes, pegs, rabbit holes and other trip hazards as you go around the campsite and make sure any mobile caravan steps are secure.

**⚠ Car Park Barriers** - When entering or leaving the Park out of Park opening hours, the car park barriers should be locked open when passing through and immediately locked shut when the vehicle has passed through. The car park barriers should be pushed into the desired position and not pulled towards the person completing the operation to prevent feet entrapment.

## ELECTRICAL HOOK-UP

Electric hook-ups are included for caravans and tents. The voltage limit of the electricity supply is 10amps. If more electricity is used then the supply will trip.

10amps is a good supply and will run pretty much everything except a domestic microwave. It is not enough to run everything at once though. If you use more than one thing at once it may cause the supply to trip out. Therefore it is wise to adopt the 'one on, one off' rule.


